**Capital Improvement Projects:** All Capital Improvement Projects will be updated on the CIPTracker Report on at least a monthly basis.

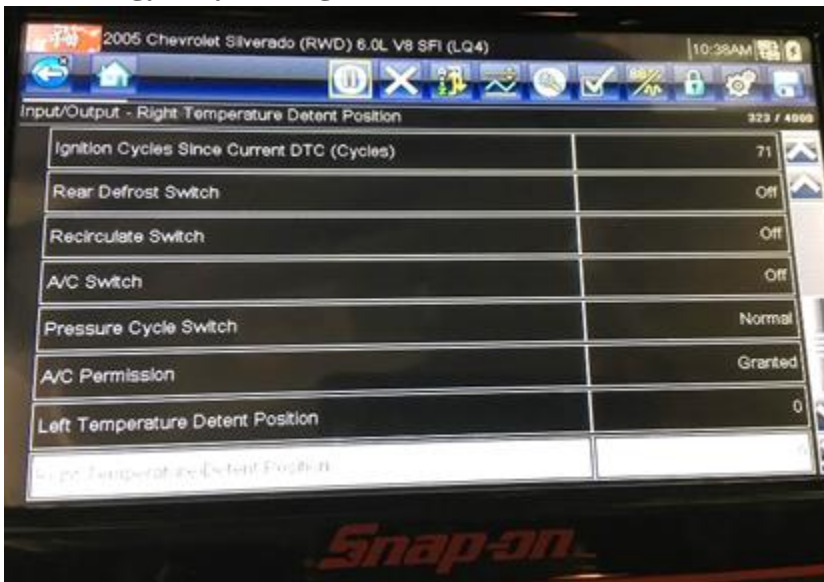

## Technology Plays a Huge Role in Fleet



Computer diagnostic equipment for cars and trucks is expensive, changes constantly and has become indispensable for locating the source of problems on virtually every system from the turbocharge to the fuel level gauge. Even when diagnosing the AC system of a 2005 Chevy Silverado, having the right computer-based tool, such as the Snap-On Solus shown above, makes all the difference.

**New Police Officers:** The three newest police officers have completed their training program and are on their own!

**Police Department Background Updates:** Background investigations are currently in progress for 1 police officer and 1 dispatcher (our only remaining vacancies).

**Wilson Park Renovation:** Below is a picture of the Wilson Park renovation. It was contractually completed late August with the exception of the slide. The slide replacement is a different contract. We were able to recycle about 70 yards of AB from the site and give it to the streets department for alley ways etc. The playground will remain closed for another week or so until the slide is installed. The slide had a crack and could not be repaired. It is a 12' spiral slide.

**Airport Material Clean-up (CIP 392) Finished:** CIP 392 was created to clean-up material and debris that had accumulated throughout the years at the Lincoln Airport. A contract was created with McGuire Pacific Constructors and the work has recently been finalized. Photos are shown below. The Notice of Completion will be taken to Council in October.

**Open Enrollment:** Open Enrollment will begin on Monday, September 10, 2018 and will continue through Friday, October 5, 2018. Any changes made to medical, dental or vision coverages will take effect on January 1, 2019. Staff interested in changing medical plans or adding/deleting eligible dependents from their plans should make these changes during Open Enrollment. Otherwise, it will take a “qualifying event” to make changes to a person’s health insurance.
