RaceDay Cycle & Multisport Opens One of a Kind Shop in Lincoln


This "outdoor experience" shop features road and triathlon bikes, eBikes, bicycle service, running shoes and apparel, multisport items and a cafe. Located

Foreign Trade Zones

Did you know that Lincoln has the distinction of having Foreign Trade Zone #143 (FTZ) at the Lincoln AirCenter Business Park? Foreign Trade Zones are designated areas within the United States where qualifying businesses are considered "out of the country" for customs purposes. Businesses can reduce costs by deferring, reducing or eliminating customs duties on imported products and materials. Merchandise exported from, or imported into, an FTZ is excluded from customs duties and excise taxes until the product leaves the FTZ for U.S. consumption. Companies may import foreign and domestic merchandise for storage, display, assembly, manufacture, processing or packaging.
