Natural Passages, LLC, proposes to develop the Gladding Eternal Preserve, a green burial cemetery, on a 160.3-acre site located at the southeast corner of Gladding Road and Fleming Road. The site would be developed as a green burial cemetery and managed as a conservation property. Approximately 61.3 acres of the site will be used for interments and will accommodate approximately 10,000 to 15,000 graves and approximately 4,000 plots for cremains at completion. The balance of the site will be left in its natural condition. Publicly-accessible trails will provide access and connect the interment areas. Cemeteries are an allowed use in the Farm (F) zoning district with a Conditional Use Permit.
