KB Homes Design Review: On November 20, 2019, the Design Review Board met for their monthly scheduled meeting to review and discuss one (1) Specific Development Plan (Design Review) application for KB Homes on assessor's parcel number (APN) 021-231-018. Overall, the design review members were in support of the KB Homes Design Review application and thus recommended the Planning Commission approve the plans. Prior to presenting the plans to the Planning Commission, as recommended by the board the applicant will need to make minor changes to their plans. The item is tentatively scheduled for Planning Commission on December 18th at 6:00 pm.

Planning Commission: On November 20, 2019, the Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing to consider a Tentative Parcel Map to divide 18.33 acres into two (2) parcels on assessor's parcel number 021-564-001. The property is located on the southwest corner of the intersection of Aviation Boulevard and Venture Drive. The item is tentatively scheduled for City Council on January 14, 2020.

Twelve Bridges Library: The library has completed four focus groups and two community engagements sessions in order to gain community insights as the library determines its goals and priorities for the next several years.

National Emergency Drill: On Wednesday, November 13th, Lincoln Police and Fire personnel participated in a national emergency drill at the California Independent System Operator (Cal ISO). The function of this drill was to test the electric industry's response to simulated attacks against the electric grid.

Officer Rayback: Lincoln Police Officer Todd Rayback retired on Friday, November 15th, after serving the City of Lincoln for 22 years.

6th Annual Turkey Drive: On November 21st the Lincoln Fire Department held their 6th Annual Turkey Drive at Station 34. Our amazing community donated over 1200 frozen turkeys that were distributed to The Salt Mine and the Placer Food Bank.

Community Development Department: The Community Development Department is currently updating its Development Activity Report and anticipates having it updated in the next couple of weeks.

Next Generation 911 (NG911): Police and Fire Dispatch is moving towards implementing the Next Generation 911 (NG911) system. Vendors identified by CalOES have been installing equipment which will enhance our accuracy and information availability for 911 calls. This upgrade is being done at no cost to the City of Lincoln.
