







City of Lincoln 2020 Districting

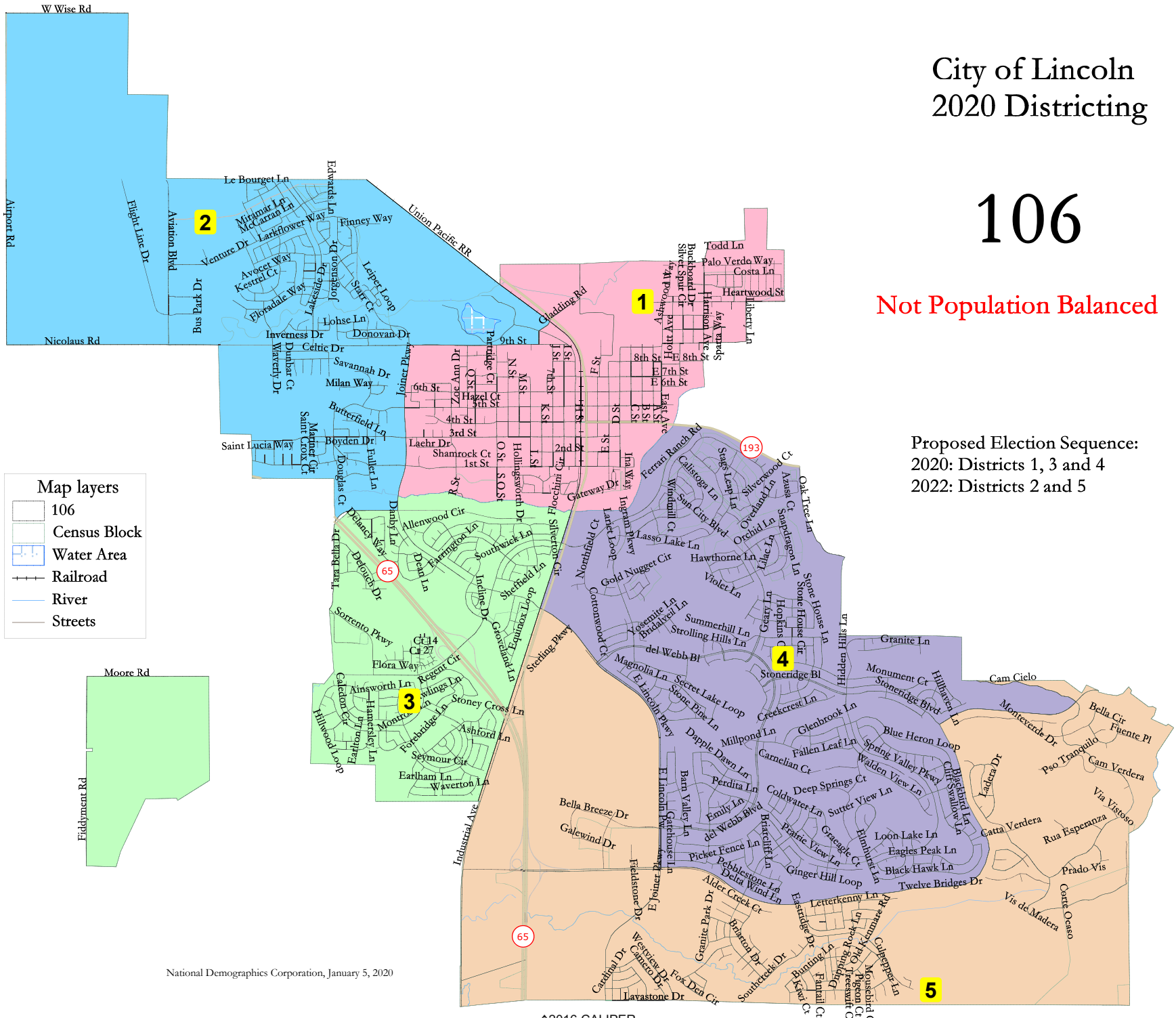
