City of Lincoln Housing Element Update: With the help of PlaceWorks Inc., the Community Development Department held its first virtual workshop to discuss the City's 2021-2029 Housing Element and Safety Element update. The meeting occurred on Tuesday, July 21st at 6:00 pm via an online platform where approximately 14 individuals attended. The group met with City staff for about an hour where they posed a variety of questions related to affordable housing. A recap of the meeting is found on the City's website under the "City News". Moving forward, City staff will consider all the comments when drafting the Housing and Safety Element.

Outdoor Dining: The City of Lincoln adopted Temporary Outdoor Dining Guidelines on June 4, 2020. Since that time, staff has been working with the local restaurant community to transition to outdoor dining to comply with the Governor’s new coronavirus restrictions. Face Covering and Hand Sanitizer Distribution: The City has free hand sanitizer and face coverings available for Lincoln Businesses. Supplies can be picked up at City Hall or from one of the local volunteers distributing supplies.

Economic Development Committee: Staff is working to develop a strategy to propose to City Council to restructure the Economic Development Committee.
