CARES Act Grant: The California Department of Housing and Community Development (Department) announced the availability of approximately \$18.7 million in new federal funds for the Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus Response Round 1 (CDBG-CV1) funding for local assistance. Funding is made available pursuant to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act signed into law March 27, 2020. Funding is available on an allocation basis for eligible non-entitlement jurisdictions, and will serve the same jurisdictions as the state administered CDBG program. The City of Lincoln is eligible to receive \$181,07 in funding through the grant program. A proposal for use of the funds will be heard by the City Council on Tuesday, September 8, 2020 at the regular City Council Meeting. Please refer to the meeting agenda for details.

Looking Forward

Love Lincoln: The Love Lincoln Shop Local Program is going to be focusing on local retail and restaurants. Want to be spotlighted in our new outreach campaign, reach out to jennifer.hines@lincolnca.gov

Interactive Development Activity Map: The department of Community Development proudly introduces an interactive development activity map. The map is available for viewing on the City's home page. This new and enhanced interactive map will allow you to view current, approved, or under construction private development projects in the City. The map provides project specifics, project location, and project manager information.

Placer Shares: Grant applications for Placer Shares can be submitted through September 7, 2020. Small businesses and nonprofits in Placer County may be eligible for up to \$10,000 in grant funding. Eligible restaurants and bars in Placer County may also begin applying for \$1,000 in grant funding through the Placer Shares Eats & Drinks program. More information and application workshops are available on the Placer Shares website.

Evictions: The Trump Administration published a fact sheet on efforts to stop evictions during the pandemic. Following an Executive Order by President Trump, the CDC is using its authority to temporarily halt evictions through the end of 2020 in an effort to slow the spread of COVID-19. Governor Newsom also announced that he has signed a new law, the Tenant, Homeowner, and Small Landlord Relief and Stabilization Act that includes protections for tenants from evictions due to COVID19-related back rent through February 1, 2021, and extends anti-foreclosure protections in the Homeowner Bill of Rights to small landlords. Tenants are still responsible for paying unpaid amounts to landlords, but those unpaid amounts cannot be the basis for an eviction.
