Building Permits Issued: As the year 2020 came to a close, we wanted to thank our Community Development Department (CDD) staff for their flexibility and positive attitude during the pandemic. CDD has shown resilience through these unprecedented times and it is evident in the total number of permits processed last year. CDD staff reviewed, issued, and inspected a total of 3,010 building permits in 2020. Thank you CDD front counter staff, building inspectors, planners, and office staff for everything you did last year, we appreciate all their hard work.

To our builders and community, CDD staff is considered an essential activity and will continue to accept, process, issue, and inspect building permits as they are submitted during the Regional Stay at Home Order. The CDD counter on the 2nd floor will continue to stay open Monday through Friday between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm.

Looking Forward

January Planning Commission: On January 20, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. the Planning Commission will hold a virtual public hearing to consider the Meadowlands Linear Park and High-Density Residential projects. The first application is brought forward by the City of Lincoln, the City is requesting to amend the General Plan Land Use Map and Zoning Map to reduce the size of the planned linear park within the Meadowlands. The second application submitted by Jen California 14 LLC is to consider a Small Lot Tentative Subdivision Map to subdivide the parcel into 81 single-family residential parcels and amend the Meadowlands General Development Plan to allow for the proposed high density residential detached product. Copies of the submitted applications are available for public review during normal business hours at the Community Development Department counter.
