Twelve Bridges Library’s Summer Reading Success: 727 readers of all ages took part in the Library’s Summer Reading Program, including over 200 who completed the program. This is a 36% increase in participation over Summer 2020. These readers read over 4300 books and almost 83,000 minutes over the course of eight weeks, and the Library distributed over 770 books to readers as rewards.

New Public Safety Dispatchers: The Police Department is working on filling three dispatcher vacancies. On 8/4/21, one dispatcher was hired with a state date in late August. Two other candidates are still in backgrounds.

Hiring Lincoln Police Officers: The Police Department is working to fill seven police vacancies. We currently have nine candidates in backgrounds.

Coffee with a Cop & Pastries with Probation: On 7/29/21 Lincoln Police Department along with Placer County Probation held a meet and greet event at Rebel Hen. Our very own Councilmember William “Bill” Lauritsen stopped in to say hello.

Looking Forward (These items occur after August 6, 2021)

New Twelve Bridges Library Hours: The Library will expand its hours beginning August 19th, when Twelve Bridges High School opens. During the Western Placer Unified School District’s school year, the Library will be open 9 am to 5 pm Monday-Thursday and Saturday, and 9 am to 3 pm on Friday. During the summer, the Library will return to its current schedule. These additional hours will allow the Library to better serve both the high school and the greater Lincoln community.

Joiner Park Recycling: We are excited to announce that the Joiner Park Parking Lot Expansion project is complete. The cardboard recycling bins will be returned to their newly concreted area for public use starting Monday, August 9, 2021.

Verdera Pressure Reducing (PRV) Replacement Project: Construction bids are being evaluated and reviewed by the project team for the Verdera Pressure Reducing Valve project that replaces the existing underground pressure reducing valve vault with a larger valve and new fire hydrant. The upgraded vault will include a double hatch lid, bypass system piping, valves and appearances, electrical and adding SCADA connections to the existing control panel. A new bypass line installed around the main PRV will allow the City to isolate and work on the main PRV valve in off-peak periods and continue to serve customers while completing the work. The addition of the larger vault with the new bypass will allow sufficient room for the operator to turn on and off the pilot isolation valves, make critical pressure and flow adjustments, flush the strainer and release air from the bonnet as needed.
