INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING ENGINEERS, STATIONARY ENGINEERS, LOCAL 39


This side letter agreement amends the SIDE LETTER DATED 10/25/2016 which amended the Memorandum of Understanding of all Classic Employees in the Professional Administrative Group for the contract period of April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2018.

The purpose of the amendment to side letter is to correct the previous omission of Recreation, Airport, Transit and Parks/Facilities Management classic employees to the other city divisions impacted by the side letter, and correct a typo from CCR 271 to CCR 571.


ARTICLE 4      Salary Administration

Section 4.7 (b) Rental and Maintenance of Uniforms. The City shall pay for the rental and maintenance of required shirts for employees in Code Enforcement, Fleet, Streets, Wastewater, Water, Solid Waste, Recreation, Airport, Transit and Parks/Facilities Management not to exceed \$600 per year per employee. The monetary value of this required clothing for classic employees is defined as special compensation by CCR 571, and must be reported as special compensation as earned for classic employees. The annual monetary value of the rental and maintenance of uniforms for classic employees shall be determined on an annual fiscal year basis through the City's procurement process.




