Lincoln, CA, March 5, 2025 — The City of Lincoln Fire Department is urging residents to stay informed about the newly released 2025 CAL FIRE Fire Hazard Severity Zones (FHSZ) Map, which identifies areas at heightened risk for wildfires. Developed by CAL FIRE under state-mandated guidelines, these updates play a critical role in fire safety regulations and community preparedness.

"The updated fire hazard severity zones are an important tool in protecting our community," said Deputy Fire Chief Anthony Mejia. "We encourage residents to review the new designations and take proactive steps to safeguard their homes and families."

- Check Your Zone: Use the FHSZ Interactive Map Tool on the City of Lincoln website to determine if your home or neighborhood is affected.

- **Read the FAQ Sheet:** Find answers to common questions about fire hazard severity zones and what the changes mean for you.
