The City of Lincoln appreciates your business year-round and would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for being great customers. We have a few friendly reminders about your trash, food scraps, recycling and green waste that we wanted to share with you so that you are better equipped in 2022.

Did you know food scraps and other organic waste make up half of what Californians dump in landfills and that organic waste in landfills emits methane which is a climate super pollutant?

In 2016, the State enacted SB1383 to address climate change. This legislation will take effect January 1, 2022 and will establish targets for recycling organic waste and recovering edible food by 2025. Reducing organic waste in landfills will have the fastest impact on climate change. City staff has worked hard to be in a position to comply with State regulations and targets.

What can our residents do? Try to reduce the amount of food scraps and waste that go into the trash. Check out savethefood.com for inspiration and helpful advice. Residents should continue to dispose of food scraps and waste consistent with the "one big bin" approach.

Friendly Reminders:

- The Lincoln Solid Waste team works every weekday of the year, including ALL holidays. There are no exceptions.
- Garbage and green waste cans should be placed at the curb no later that 6:00 a.m. or the night before.
- Due to varying conditions, drivers may alter or switch routes which will change collection times. Pickups may occur at any time between 6:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. If you think your can was missed, please call after 2 p.m.
- Please do not over-fill containers. The lid must be able to close, and contents must fall freely from the can. Overstuffed cans will not be serviced and will be tagged with a note.
- Cardboard recycling bins are placed at Joiner Park and the Twelve Bridges Library. Please do not leave cardboard on the ground or against the bin. If the bins are full, please take it to the dump, or return another time.

BASICSERVICES

Residents receive the following basic services:

Garbage Collection - 96 - gallon container service is provided on a weekly basis.

<u>Green Waste Collection</u> - 96 - gallon container; green waste is collected on an alternating week basis. The collection schedule is included at the back of the Guide to Solid Waste Services.

Free Electronic Waste and FOG (Fats, Oils, and Grease) Collection Service - call Public Works at (916) 434-2450 to schedule a pickup date.

Service Questions

For questions regarding your designated collection day, please call Public Works at **(916) 434-2450** between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

HOLIDAY/SERVICES

Garbage and/or green waste is picked up on <u>ALL</u> holidays, even if the holiday falls on a weekday. However, <u>it may be picked up at a different time of day than usual</u>. Please make sure containers are placed at the curb by <u>6</u> a.m. or the night before.

SPECIAL SERVICES

Missed Collection

For missed collection, call (916) 434-2450.

Missed collection calls will only be accepted up to 48 hours from the scheduled pick up day. A \$25.00 fee will be assessed for return pickups.

Extra Collection

If your container is full before or after collection day, please call (916) 434-2450 to request extra pickup service for an added charge.*

*EXTRA FEES WILL APPLY FOR EXTRA PICKUP AND/OR RETURN SERVICE REQUESTS.

Requests for special service must be requested by the bill-paying homeowner/tenant whose name appears on the account only. All requests will be verified.

CONTAINERPLACEMENT

Containers must be at street-side no later than 6 a.m. on your scheduled service day, including holidays.

Listed below are guidelines for street-side container placement:

- Place containers at street-side (not on the sidewalk) with the handles facing the house.
- Do not block pedestrian traffic.
- Place containers at least five (5) feet apart from one another.
- Keep containers a minimum of six (6) feet away from cars, boats, and other stationary objects to avoid risk of private property damage.

Once containers are serviced on collection day, please remove them from the street. The appearance of neighborhoods greatly improves when residents store containers in their side or back yard.



OTHER IMPORTANT SERVICE INFORMATION

- Materials must fall freely from the container(s) when dumped.
- Container will not be picked up if it is:
 - Overfull
 - · Not completely closed
 - Not at street side by 6 a.m.
 - Inaccessible
 - Contains unacceptable materials.
- Please bag all trash to avoid spilling during collection.

2022 Service Schedule

HOUSEHOLD WASTE: The garbage container will be serviced every week on your regular collection day.

GREEN WASTE: Green waste is serviced every other week. Each street has been assigned a color (blue or yellow). Blue streets will be serviced on the blue weeks on the schedule below.
