The purpose of this Public Hearing will be to take public testimony concerning the intention of the levy and collection of assessments for the Lighting and Landscaping Benefit Assessment District Number 1 ("District") for the Fiscal Year 2022/23. Proposed assessments are outlined in the Engineer's Annual Levy Report on file at the Development Services Department, 600 Sixth Street, Lincoln, CA, 95648 which details the annual assessments.

The assessments collected through the District provide funding for maintenance and operations of parks, open space areas, landscaping and lighting improvements, traffic signals and associated appurtenant facilities located within the City of Lincoln.

Any interested person may file a written protest with the City Clerk prior to the conclusion of the Public Hearing, or, having previously filed a protest, may file a written withdrawal of that protest. A written protest shall state all grounds of objection and a protest by a property owner shall contain a description sufficient to identify the property owned by such property owner. At the Public Hearing, all interested persons shall be afforded the opportunity to hear and be heard.

The location of the Public Hearing is fully accessible to mobility impaired individuals.
