Defendant and respondent California Department of Social Services (CDSS) requests judicial notice of the existence and existence of the content of a single document: a page from CDSS's official government website titled "Letters and Notices," which lists and includes links to All-County Letters (ACLs) and other instructions dating as far back as 1974 that CDSS has issued in connection with programs it administers, including, in addition to ACLs: All County Information Notices (ACINs), All County Welfare Director Letters (ACDWLs), All Tribal Leaders Letters (ATLLs), Child Care Bulletins (CCBs), County Fiscal Letters (CFLs), County Fiscal Information Notices (CFINs), and Notices of Form Changes (GEN 127s). A screenshot of CDSS's "Letters and Notices" webpage is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and is available at <a href="https://www.cdss.ca.gov/inforesources/letters-and-notices">https://www.cdss.ca.gov/inforesources/letters-and-notices</a> (last visited December 20, 2024).

The Court may take judicial notice of the existence of the content of CDSS "Letters and Notices" webpage, because the webpage constitutes an "official act of the executive branch" of the State of California and a record whose existence "is not subject to reasonable dispute and is capable of immediate and accurate determination by resort to reliable sources." (Evid. Code, § 452, subds. (c) and (h); see *Shaw v. People ex rel. Chiang* (2009) 175 Cal.App.4th 577, 606 and fn. 10 [taking judicial notice of content of government website pursuant to Evidence Code section 452, subdivisions (c) and (h), in connection with interpretation of terms of statute], disapproved on other grounds by *County of San Diego v. Com. on State Mandates* (2018) 6 Cal.5th 196, 214, fn. 4; *Ragland v. U.S. Bank Nat. Assn.* (2012) 209 Cal.App.4th 182, 193 [taking judicial notice of existence of websites].)

Judicial notice is mandatory if a party requests it and (1) gives the adverse parties sufficient notice of the request to enable the adverse parties to prepare to respond to the request; and (2) furnishes the court with enough information to enable the court to take judicial notice. (Evid. Code, § 453, subds. (a) & (b).) This request and CDSS's demurrer provide notice to plaintiff City of Lincoln (City) and the City has a full opportunity to respond within the same time as it has to file its opposition to CDSS's demurrer. CDSS also, with this request, provides the Court and the City with enough information to enable the court to take judicial notice, including a copy of the "Letters and Notices" webpage, the link at which the page may be located and viewed on the

1 internet, and points and authorities in support of its request.
