The intent of this public hearing is to collect feedback on the draft 2026-30 Consolidated Plan and 2026 Annual Action Plan for the City of Lincoln before submitting the plans to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on June 3, 2026.

The City has been allocated \$272,325 in housing and community development funds from HUD in 2026. The 2026-30 Consolidated Plan articulates the priority needs and goals the City will undertake over the next five years while the 2026 Annual Action Plan proposes a one-year spending plan for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. A 30-day public comment period will be held from April 20th to May 20, 2026, to provide the public with the opportunity to review and comment on the draft 2026-30 Consolidated Plan and 2026 Annual Action Plan. The Consolidated Plan is designed to help local jurisdictions assess affordable housing needs and market conditions, and to make data-driven, place-based investment decisions. The consolidated planning process serves as the framework for a community-wide dialogue to identify housing and community development priorities that align and focus funding from the Community Planning and Development (CPD) formula block grant programs, including the CDBG program.
